## MESSAGE FROM DR. LENNON, PROUD PRINCIPAL

Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the second week of November. Did everyone remember to make sure the clocks are showing the correct time due to the annual time change? Yes, daylight savings time ended and we fell back 1-hour this past weekend.

This is going to be a really short week for our students as we have no school the next two days. However, please join your child's teacher for our Fall conference tomorrow. Teachers will be conducting conferences between 12:30 PM and 7:30 PM. I hope that everyone took the opportunity to sign up for a parent-teacher conference. We will not be in session on Tuesday, because it is Election Day.

Some VERY IMPORTANT information to remember:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - ***Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.***
- School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
- **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:00 am - 4:30 pm.
- **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to [CNAAttendance@casdschools.org](mailto:CNAAttendance@casdschools.org). The note for early dismissals should contain:

Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#.

**It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.**

**All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.**

The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).

- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.

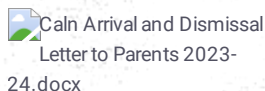
