PLEASE REMEMBER:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered <u>tardy after 9:30 AM</u> *Dr.* Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.
- School instructional times are 9:15 am 3:45 pm.
- Main Office Hours: <u>The main office hours are 8:30 am 4:30 pm</u>. Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
- Early Dismissal: A note/email should be sent in the morning to <u>CNAttendance@casdschools.org</u>. The note for early dismissals should contain: Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. <u>It is very important to get these</u> <u>notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.</u> All early dismissals should be completed at the main office <u>by 3:15</u>. Students must be signed out. <u>Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.</u> The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS)**: We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.



Nurses Notes from Mrs. Diamond

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am working on vision, hearing, height and weight screenings. If you get a referral in the mail, your child may need to see the doctor if they did not pass a hearing or vision screening.

We have seen a lot of different ailments. If your child is having itching, redness, drainage or crusty eyes upon awakening in the morning, please keep them home and take them to the doctor. We have seen Pink Eye at school. If they have Pink Eye, they need to be on eye drops (ordered by your doctor or health care provider) for 24 hours before returning to school. Please keep your child home if they are constantly coughing, have been vomiting, or have a fever. They need to be 24 hours fever free, and vomit free before returning to school.

We are again in need of children's size 6 and 8 pants for the nurse's office. If you have those sizes and want to donate, please drop them off at Caln. They are much appreciated. Any questions please call or email me.
