

Message from the Principal, Dr. Lennon



Hello Caln Families!

Welcome to the third week of April! We are gearing up for PSSA testing and I would like to remind everyone that our students in grades 3-5 will begin testing next week (April 23rd - May 5th). Our staff and I expect that all students in grades K-5 will arrive to

school on time since the main hallway needs to be especially quiet and without unnecessary interruptions. Our 4th grade students are housed in this hallway and small group testing will occur in this hallway, too. Therefore, it is very important to remind everyone of our tardy or late policy.

Student arrival begins at 9:15 AM and students are considered tardy after 9:30 AM. If you or a family member is dropping off a student at the front of the building, which means you missed parent drop off to the east side of our building and it is after 9:30, then you must park in a parking spot and bring your child(ren) into the main entrance to sign them in. It is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to make sure that students arrive to school on time. In addition, for the safety of your child(ren), walking them into school is the safest policy. Furthermore, since our students are in elementary school, it is best for the parent or guardian to state the reason for the lateness.

In case you missed the message that I sent home via School Messenger regarding PSSA testing, this is the 2nd week that I have included the district copy and the school copy of these communications below. Please be sure to read them carefully, especially since some district policies have changed this school year. In addition, our testing schedule has been included within the school letter. Again, it is very important that all of our students report to school on time during the two weeks of testing. When students arrive to school late, this causes major disruption to the main office, main hallway where 4th graders are taking the test, and the secure monitoring of the testing. Please plan ahead of time and please adhere to our attendance policy.

I hope to see many of our families and staff in attendance at our Spring Fair this Friday evening. I wish to thank the PTA for their hard work in planning and preparing for this event. Please remember that the PTA needs volunteers to help to make this event a success for all. See the PTA message below for more information.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered <u>tardy after 9:30 AM</u> *Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.*
- School instructional times are 9:15 am 3:45 pm.
- Main Office Hours: The main office hours are 8:30 am 4:30 pm.
 Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
- Early Dismissal: A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for early dismissals should contain:

Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. <u>It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.</u>

All early dismissals should be completed at the main office <u>by 3:15</u>. Students must be signed out. <u>Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.</u>

The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).

- Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder: If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS): We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY. I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.


