#### PLEASE REMEMBER:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered <u>tardy after 9:30 AM</u> *Dr.* Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.
- School instructional times are 9:15 am 3:45 pm.
- Main Office Hours: <u>The main office hours are 8:30 am 4:30 pm</u>. Staff hours are 8:45-4:15 pm.
- Early Dismissal: A note/email should be sent in the morning to <u>CNAttendance@casdschools.org</u>. The note for early dismissals should contain: Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. <u>It is very important to get these</u> <u>notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.</u> All early dismissals should be completed at the main office <u>by 3:15</u>. Students must be signed out. <u>Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.</u>

The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).

- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS)**: We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.



## **NURSE'S CORNER**

#### **Nurses Notes from Mrs. Diamond**

Hello from the Nurse's office!

We are very busy with cold and flu season. If your child has a fever, please remember they need to be 24 hours fever free before returning to school. Please keep children home if having vomiting or diarrhea before school. Also keep your child home if they are having a constant cough or runny nose.

If your child needs a change of clothing, please make sure they bring a clothing change to school. If your child borrows pants from school, please wash and return them to the nurse.

If your student needs to take any medication at school, remember to send in a Drs order. I will also send home a parent med consent form for you to sign.

If your student tests positive for Covid I am sending the guidelines we are using for school:

Day Zero is the day your student starts symptoms

Day 1-5 please keep your student home

If your student feels well enough to attend school by day 6, they may retrun. If they are coughing a lot or do not feel well, please keep them home until they feel well.

Day 6-10 please send your student to school with a mask.

Please dress your child in warm clothing as students will be going out for recess in the winter months.
