Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the third week of October!

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Public Information Officer, Kim Mattson, from the *Thorndale Fire Company*, along with the several firefighters for conducting the fire safety presentations that were held last Friday. Our students learned many important fire safety tips from Ms. Mattson and most of our students were able to tour one of the two fire trucks. One of the most important takeaways from this event is the importance for families to establish and practice an escape plan. Please see the two flyers below that will help your family to create an escape plan in case of an emergency.

The top 2 reminders for this week are as follows:

Our monthly Caln PTA meeting is scheduled this Tuesday starting at 6:30 pm in our cafeteria or you may join us virtually using the zoom link below. I am excited to announce that our *Superintendent, Dr. Van Vooren*, will also be in attendance. We are looking forward to hearing from our amazing leader at our meeting. The second important reminder is that our students have a half day this Wednesday. We promptly dismiss our students at 12:30 pm. All staff will be participating in professional development during the afternoon. If you need to speak with us, please send an email and we will get back to you on Thursday.

Do you know our three main Caln expectations? *RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, and SAFETY.* Students are expected to practice our expectations everywhere they go.

Everyone at Caln has been informed about our expectations. We will continue to hold our expectations to a high regard in and around our Caln community. It is also imperative that our parents hold their children accountable too. We must work together to ensure that all students are learning in a safe environment and that your child(ren) follow these expectations each and every day. Please keep in mind that our next Have A Hoot day is quickly approaching and all students must earn this special day this month based upon them practicing their best behavior.

A few important reminders are listed below, beginning with any new information.

- Our school nurse, Mrs. Caren Diamond, is here to help students during the school day when students need her care from scrapes, bumps, allergies, and illnesses during school time. Please be sure to monitor your child's safety and care at home. If needed, there are several Urgent Care Centers in and around our community during home time and on the weekends. I have included a few helpful resources below.
- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered tardy after 9:30 AM - attendance is being closely monitored.
- School instructional times are 9:15 am 3:45 pm.
- Main Office Hours: The main office hours are 8:00 am -4:30 pm.
- Early Dismissal: A note/email should be sent in the morning to <u>CNAttendance@casdschools.org</u>. The note for early dismissals should contain:
 Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#. It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.
 All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.
 The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
- Parent-Pick-Up Notes & Reminder: Thank you for having patience with us as we work to make our afternoon dismissal more efficient. If your child needs to be picked up for an early dismissal or rides a school bus, please help us with this by sending a parent pick-up note into school with your child(ren) or email cnattendance@casdschools.org. If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS): We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: RESPECT,
 RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY. I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.


