MESSAGE FROM DR. LENNON, PROUD PRINCIPAL

Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the fourth and almost final week of October!

The PTA Board and I wish to thank Dr. VanVooren for attending our October PTA meeting and providing all participants with detailed information about the Facilities Plan and the future of Caln. Our next PTA meeting will be held November 21st.

I wish to also thank our Art Goes To School volunteer for bringing a different perspective to the lives of our students about art education (see photo to the left of AGTS in Mrs. Schmoyer's third grade classroom).

*Do you know why we celebrate **Have A Hoot Day** once a month at Caln?* Our staff teaches three very important school-wide expectations: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, and SAFETY**. Students are expected to practice our expectations everywhere they go each and every day. This includes on the school bus, in the cafeteria, at recess, in specials, in the hallways, in the classrooms, in the group restrooms, and anywhere in our community. Students earn the privilege of choosing a top choice club for 40-minutes once a month. They earn this privilege by making sure that their behavior is in great standing throughout the month prior to the event. Students who are unable to follow our Caln expectations will not earn this privilege and will be provided re-teaching lessons on our PBIS expectations by our staff members during the 40-minutes instead of participating in their "top choice" club.

The Criteria for earning Have A Hoot Day.

1. No documented behavior incidents the month prior.
2. Received the 5th bus referral that month prior.
3. Too many internal calls to the behavior interventionist to support the child in school.

Note: Dr. Lennon is the sole decision-maker on who earns or does not earn Have A Hoot Day. The decisions are based on this criteria while also ensuring that individualized behavior support plans are being implemented with fidelity.

Everyone at Caln has been informed about our expectations. We will continue to hold our expectations to a high regard in and around our Caln community. It is also imperative that our

together to ensure that all students are learning in a safe environment and that your child(ren) follow these expectations each and every day.

Some VERY IMPORTANT information to remember:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - *Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.*
- School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
- **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:00 am - 4:30 pm.
- **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for early dismissals should contain:
Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#.
It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.
All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.
The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.
