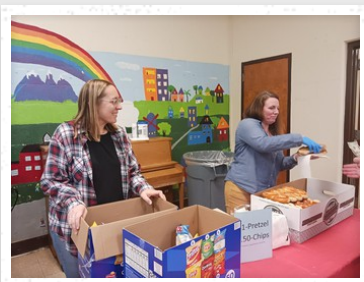

Some VERY IMPORTANT information to remember:

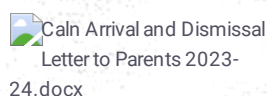
- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - *Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.*
- School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
- **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:00 am - 4:30 pm.
- **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for early dismissals should contain:
Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#.
It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.
All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.
The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).
- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.

- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.

NURSES NOTES FROM MRS. DIAMOND

Hello from the Nurse's Office!

We are full swing into cold and flu season. Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well.

All children with fevers need to be fever free for at least 24 hours before returning to school. If your child is ill during the day and needs to go home, I will be calling you to pick up your child. There may be times I can't reach you by phone, (I understand you may be at work), so in that event I will be emailing or using your emergency contact numbers to come pick up your student.

If you have medication that your child needs to take at school, we need a Doctor's order and Parent Consent Form signed. These can be faxed or emailed.

If you haven't turned in your kindergarten child's physical or dental form these may also be faxed, emailed or sent in with your student.

If your child is new to CASD, we will need a Physical and Dental exam from within the past year to be submitted to the Nurse's office.
