

DAILY TRANSPORTATION UPDATE - NOVEMBER 13, 2020

Dear Coatesville Area School District,

Thank you for taking time to read another update as we work to restore bus transportation in our District. We understand how important it is to bring our students back to hybrid, in-person learning as soon as possible.

We are continuing to unravel the scheduling issues we've been facing, and are working as quickly as possible toward a resolution. Our transportation department, with the help of an experienced transportation consultant, will work through the weekend. We continue to coordinate closely with Krapf Bus. We have removed about 1,400 students from our bus rosters who have chosen virtual instruction (about 26% of our students) and this will create significant additional space on our buses.

While we are in virtual learning this coming week, we want to remind families that:

- Every Wednesday that we are in virtual learning mode will become an asynchronous day in which students can work at their own pace. Our principals will remind students and parents of this next week.
- Elementary students will revert to their virtual schedule beginning Monday, November 16.

Again, while a repeated apology will not fix our transportation problems, we want our families to know how very sorry we are for the frustration and disappointment this situation has caused. We will continue to update our families as we move toward solutions and return dates.
