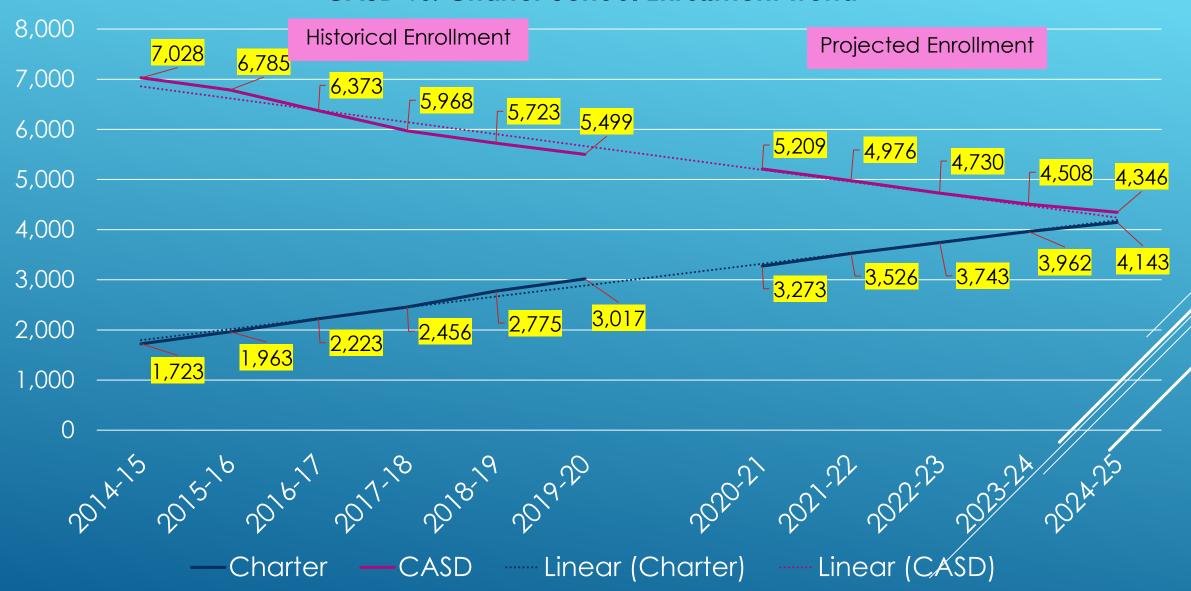

CASD vs. Charter School Enrollment Trend



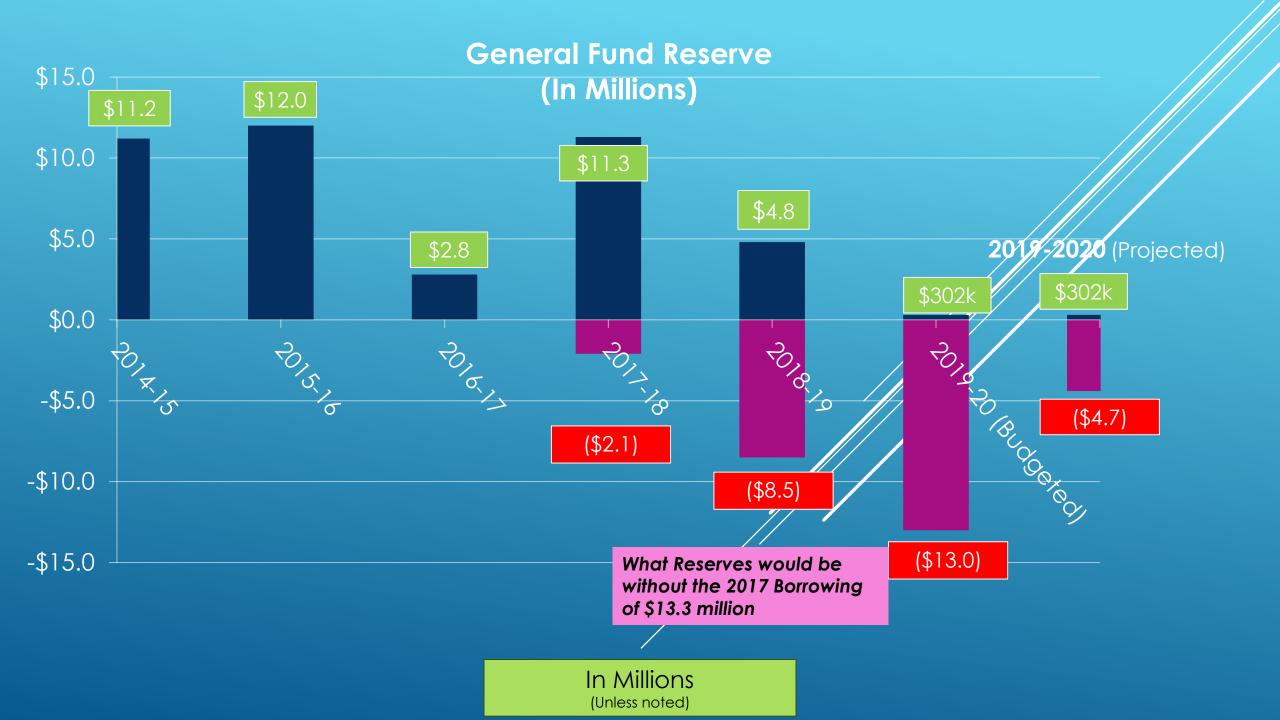

Budget Timeline

Stay within Act 1 Index



Adopt resolution before 1/9/2020 indicating CASD will stay within Index (12/17/19)

Preliminary budget adopted: 4/28/2020

Final budget adopted: 6/9/2020

Use Act 1 Index PLUS possible referendum exceptions

Preliminary budget available to public no later than 1/9/20

Board must adopt preliminary budget by 1/29/20 (1/28/20)

Board must file exceptions with PDE by 2/13/20 (1/28/20)

Final budget adopted: 6/9/2020
