


Message from Dr. Lennon, Proud Principal

Dear Caln Community,

Welcome to the final week of October and the beginning of November. Already?!

We are continuing with our tradition of holding a **Character Day Parade** inside of our school on Tuesday morning. It is only a



30-minute parade where our students get to walk in the hallways with their "costumes" (Without masks or props, please!) on as their fellow peers enjoy the scenery. I have asked for a few parent volunteers who have the appropriate district clearances for this short and brief school event. These parents will receive an email message tomorrow about the event. Do not worry about not being here, though. I will be adding a video for all to view in next week's communicator.

I expect that all of our students will be following our school-wide expectations: ***RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, and SAFETY, especially during this fun time of the year.*** Students are expected to practice our expectations everywhere they go each and every day. This includes on the school bus, in the cafeteria, at recess, in specials, in the hallways, in the classrooms, in the group restrooms, and anywhere in our community. Please remind your child(ren) that we want to see them earn the next month's **Have A Hoot Day!**

Have A Hoot Day Earning Criteria:

1. No documented behavior incidents the month prior.
2. Received the 5th bus referral that month prior.
3. Too many internal calls to the behavior interventionist to support the child in school.

Note: Dr. Lennon is the sole decision-maker on who earns or does not earn Have A Hoot Day. The decisions are based on this criteria while also ensuring that individualized behavior support plans are being implemented with fidelity.

Everyone at Caln has been informed about our expectations. We will continue to hold our expectations to a high regard in and around our Caln community. It is also imperative that our parents hold their children accountable too. We must work together to ensure that all students are learning in a safe environment and that your child(ren) follow these expectations each and every day.

Some VERY IMPORTANT information to remember:

- School doors open for students at 9:15 AM. Your child is considered **tardy after 9:30 AM** - ***Dr. Lennon is closely monitoring student attendance.***
- School instructional times are 9:15 am - 3:45 pm.
- **Main Office Hours:** The main office hours are 8:00 am - 4:30 pm.
- **Early Dismissal:** A note/email should be sent in the morning to CNAAttendance@casdschools.org. The note for

early dismissals should contain:

Student Name/Teacher/Date and Time of

Dismissal/Reason/Name of Adult picking up and relationship/Parent Signature and parent daytime phone#.

It is very important to get these notes into your child's teacher or to the main office prior to 2:00 pm.

All early dismissals should be completed at the main office by 3:15. Students must be signed out. Dismissals after 3:15 will be in the parent pick-up line.


The adult picking up must bring a government issued Photo ID (preferably a driver's license).

- **Parent-Pick-Up Line Reminder:** If you are picking up your child from school, please do your best to keep your vehicle to the far right when pulling out of our parking lot so that traffic does not block or slow down the emergency vehicles at the neighboring firehouse.
- **Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS):** We practice 3 important expectations at Caln: **RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY & SAFETY.** I ask that all adults be role models for our children/our students. This is a team effort.

We will continue to work together to ensure that your child's learning experience at Caln Elementary School is a successful and happy one.
